



CALL FOR APPLICATIONS: 2026/2027 LANGUAGE EDUCATION POSTGRADUATE SCHOLARSHIPS IN FOUNDATIONAL LITERACY

1. Introduction

The Language Education Research Chair in Kisii University invites applications for postgraduate studies from suitably qualified candidates for a competitive research scholarship in Foundational Literacy under the Harnessing Education Research for Impact in Africa (HERI-Africa) programme. HERI Africa is a Pan-African initiative designed to revitalize Africa-led, university-based education research. Its primary goal is to boost the continent's contribution to global educational research from the current 3% to 30% by 2050. HERI Africa's focus is to strengthen Kenya's education research system to deliver credible, relevant evidence that informs policy formulation, practice, and improves learning outcomes.

2. Scope

The Successful candidates for the Masters and PhD programmes are expected to carry out research that is aligned to one or more of the following key thematic areas. The sub-themes under the broad thematic areas are not exhaustive, students will be encouraged to develop research ideas on different Foundational literacy perspectives within the African context.

- a) **Mother-Tongue and Bilingual Literacy:** developing children's' foundational literacy skills in mother-tongue and transitioning to subsequent languages.
- b) **Teacher Mentorship and Coaching:** Structured support networks for foundational literacy educators, Innovative, context-adapted classroom strategies to boost literacy learning outcomes.
- c) **Home and Community Engagement:** Parental capacity building for shared reading, storytelling, and singing with children during the early years of schooling by use of weekly SMS prompts and discussion topics to guide home literacy activities.
- d) **EdTech & AI Integration:** Deployment of high-quality digital tools and educational games to enhance children's foundational literacy learning outcomes, utilization of AI-tools for children's personalized reading practices to improve reading fluency outcomes.
- e) **Communities of Practice (CoPs):** Empowering teachers through shared learning and evidence-based methods to improve early years' foundational literacy instruction. Driving improvement in foundational literacy instruction through peer observations, collaborative material creation, and assessment strategies.
- f) **Pedagogy and Teacher Education:** Literacy Pedagogy in different contexts, Pre-Service Teacher Training: Aligning Teacher training curricula with the science of reading, Literacy assessment.

3. Eligibility Criteria

To be considered for this postgraduate scholarship, applicants must meet the Kisii University postgraduate admission criteria as outlined below:

Masters

- Applicants for a Masters degree programmes should have a minimum of Second Class Upper division in Bachelor of Education Arts (with specializations in English and Literature or Kiswahili with any other combination), Bachelor of Education- Early Childhood Development Education (ECDE), Bachelor of Education - Special Needs Education (with specializations in English and Literature or Kiswahili with any other combination) from Kisii University or Equivalent qualification from institutions recognized by the Kisii University Senate
or
- Applicants with Second Class Lower division in Bachelor of Education Arts (with specializations in English and Literature or Kiswahili with any other combination), Bachelor of Education- Early Childhood Development Education (ECDE), Bachelor of Education - Special Needs Education (with specializations in English and Literature or Kiswahili with any other combination) and at least two (2) years of relevant experience in language education, literacy programme delivery, or a related field will be considered.

- **PhD Applicants**

- The applicants for the Doctor of Philosophy should hold a relevant Masters degree from Kisii University or an accredited institution that is recognized by the Kisii University Senate.
- In addition, the applicants should submit a research concept aligned to the Foundational Literacy thematic areas specified in this call to demonstrate that they are capable of carrying out original research.
- Must be a newly admitted or continuing postgraduate student at Kisii University.

N/B.

- **Women and persons living with disabilities (PWDs) are strongly encouraged to apply.**
- Shortlisted candidates will be subjected to a suitability interview

4. Scholarship Benefits

Successful scholars will receive comprehensive support, which includes:

- **Monthly stipend:** A monthly student stipend support.
- **Research Grants:** Stipends to support fieldwork, data collection, and thesis writing
- **Conference participation and publication support:** Stipend to support conference participation and journal publication expenses
- **Supervision support:** Supervision guidance from subject matter experts

Prepare and submit the following documents in PDF format:

- Masters applicants: certified copy of Bachelor's degree certificate; certified academic transcripts for undergraduate study.
- PhD applicants: certified copy of Masters degree certificate, certified academic transcripts and two-pager Research concept.
- Reference letters from two academic referees.
